

Missouri School for the Deaf Alumni Association HALL OF FAME GUIDELINES

Criteria for Nominations of Nominee: There are three of the following categories:

- A. Athlete
- B. Coach
- C. Leader

Description of the Categories

A. Athlete

- 1. The athletic nominee must complete a waiting period of at least 10 years after graduation or leaving MSD.
- 2. As a student, this athlete must have earned athletic honors as Most Valuable Player (MVP), All-American, All-Star, or Outstanding Athlete.
- 3. Shall be nominated for MSD Hall of Fame if he/she becomes a State Champion in any sport.
- 4. An athletic team shall be nominated into MSD Hall of Fame if this team wins a State Championship or a National Deaf Championship.

B. Coach

- 1. Eligibility at least 10 years after leaving from coaching at MSD.
- 2. High School coach in any sports at MSD for at least one year with an approval of Hall of Fame committee.
- 3. Takes the team or an individual to a championship, i.e. Conference, State, Deaf National Championship, or any regional state district events.
- 4. Possesses high winning record percentage.

C. Leader

- 1. Eligibility at least 10 years following his participation in **C.** #2 and #3.
- 2. MSD Alumni who has performed outstanding roles at the local, state or national level for the Deaf community, non-profit associations or organizations.
- 3. Individuals who have volunteered their time to any Deaf organizations.
