



Missouri School for the Deaf HALL OF FAME GUIDELINES

Criteria for Nominations of Nominee: There are three of the following categories:

- A. Athlete**
- B. Coach**
- C. Leader**

Description of the Categories

A. Athlete

1. The athletic nominee must complete a waiting period of at least 10 years after graduation or leaving MSD.
2. As a student, this athlete must have earned athletic honors as Most Valuable Player (MVP), All-American, All-Star, or Outstanding Athlete.
3. Shall be nominated for MSD Hall of Fame if he/she becomes a State Champion in any sport.
4. An athletic team shall be nominated into MSD Hall of Fame if this team wins a State Championship or a National Deaf Championship.

B. Coach

1. Eligibility at least 10 years after leaving from coaching at MSD.
2. High School coach in any sports at MSD for at least one year with an approval of Hall of Fame committee.
3. Takes the team or an individual to a championship, i.e. Conference, State, Deaf National Championship, or any regional state district events.
4. Possesses high winning record percentage.

C. Leader

1. Eligibility at least 10 years following his participation in **C. #2** and **#3**.
2. MSD Alumni who has performed outstanding roles at the local, state or national level for the Deaf community, non-profit associations or organizations.
3. Individuals who have volunteered their time to any Deaf organizations.
